



The Mission of the Spencer Home Foundation is to provide funding to The Kenneth E. Spencer Memorial Home Inc. to assist them in ensuring quality of life for persons requiring long-term care.

The Kenneth E. Spencer Memorial Home Inc. is a 200-bed long-term care facility which provides various programs to meet the needs of the Greater Moncton community with:

- ✓ Nursing Home Care
- ✓ Relief Care
- ✓ Adult Day Program

The Spencer Home Foundation hosts an Annual Fundraising Banquet each year in May to raise money to purchase items not provided by the Provincial Government.

Previous fundraising campaigns have realized more than half a million dollars used to purchase items such as a new bus, a Baby Grand piano, two generators, large screen televisions, chairs, atrium furniture, gardening vehicle, multi-level dining tables, blanket warmers, and 100 dressers & night stands for Neighbourhood Two. The current project is to raise \$114,000 to purchase 100 dressers and night stands for Neighbourhood One; to date, we have raised approximately 10%.

The Foundation is currently seeking volunteers to serve on the Board. The Board meets approximately seven times a year, with no meetings taking place in during the summer months. Meetings start at 5 p.m. and last approximately one hour to one hour and a half at Spencer Home.
